## **SQUAD TIMES**

**Qualifying: Sunday, March 11<sup>th</sup> @ 10AM  
Semi Finals: One hour following Qualifying**

**Check in one hour prior to squad time (9:00 AM)**

The San Diego Queens (Women) & Masters (Men) Tournament is open to all Bowlers in the SDUSBC. Multi-Members must have purchased a Multi-Member Card (USBC Rule 101) and be currently bowling in a league in the San Diego Assoc. With 21 games or more as of April 15, 2011. (No Cards will be sold on site.)

1. Contestants of the Queens & Masters Tournament may not practice on any of the tournament lanes prior to tournament starting.
2. Bowlers will be allowed ten (10) minutes of practice on their starting lanes.
3. USBC Rule 319d will be waived.
4. Pin fall from qualifying round will not carry over.
5. The tournament champions will receive a paid entry into the 2012 SD USBC Queens & Masters Tournament.
6. Any entrant while participating, may be disqualified for any of the following reasons:
  - a. Any infraction of the rules.
  - b. Conduct derogatory to the best interest of the tournament.
  - c. Use of foreign substance which comes in contact with the approach or the lanes.
7. *Disqualification of entrant* shall result in forfeiture of the entry fee and any right to prize money.
8. Optional Side Pots.

## **Playing Format**

1. **Qualifying round:** Each bowler will bowl six (6) games across the required number of lanes moving to your right after each game. Lane assignment will be determined by the Tournament committee.
2. **Semi Finals:** \_\_\_\_\_ # of bowlers will advance to Semi Finals bowling three (3) additional games across six (6) lanes.
  - a. In the event of a tie for the last semi-finalist position, one (1) complete game will be bowled immediately. If a tie still exists at the end of game, a ninth (9<sup>th</sup>) and tenth (10<sup>th</sup>) frame will be bowled until the tie is broken. The extra frames will start on the same lane each contestant finished on. Contestant on the odd numbered lane will start first. This rule shall apply throughout the tournament whenever applicable.
3. **Finals:** The top five (5) will bowl a stepladder format to determine the winner. In the event of a tie in any stepladder position, only a ninth (9<sup>th</sup>) and tenth (10<sup>th</sup>) frame will be bowled until the tie is broken. After each match, bowlers will move to a different set of lanes.
4. Bowlers are responsible to be present at the beginning of the tournament. Should a bowler arrive after the official starting time, they will receive a zero for each frame missed.

## **Dress Code**

Collared, Mock Collared, Collarless t-shirt/sports type, dress shirts. Long pants or **knee length walking shorts** are permissible. Offensive attire, tank tops, or hats **NOT** permitted. Any dress code questions or concerns will be addressed by the Chairman of the committee.
