

SAN DIEGO USBC BOWLING ASSOCIATION

Youth Male and Female 2014 - 2015 All Star Team Requirements

A) Eligibility Requirements:

- 1. Be a member in good standing of the San Diego USBC.
- 2. Purchase your original membership card through the San Diego USBC.
- 3. Only events certified, sponsored, or conducted by the San Diego USBC will be eligible for points.
- 4. Selections will be made on the basis of overall performance, sportsmanship, character, and GPA.
- 5. Must file an All-Star application with the association office or postmarked no later than **November 15, 2014** to be eligible for the current season.
 - > League name and bowling center must be designated clearly on the application.
 - > The bowler is responsible to verify All-Star Application is on file at association office.
 - > It is the bowlers' responsibility to check for omissions, overall accuracy on printouts, and recaps.
- 6. <u>Must select a sanctioned league</u> under San Diego USBC jurisdiction in current bowling year starting September 2014 through May 2015. (or winter league starting in August)
- 7. Must have minimum average: Male 175 and Female 155 from current book.
- 8. Must have bowled 60 or more games in league designated on the application. Split season designated league that starts in September, are combined.

B) <u>Disqualification:</u>

- 1. Any bowler who exhibits poor sportsmanship during any San Diego USBC bowling event, observed by any association board member, or is reported to San Diego USBC, shall be subject to disqualification.
- 2. Any bowler (or parent/guardian) who submits a "bad check" (NSF) through San Diego USBC, shall be subject to disqualification.

C) Method of turning in scores:

- 1. Any All-Star Committee or Association Board member may accept all applicants' scores for bowling year September 2014 thru May 2015.
 - Accepting Committee/Board member is expected to write the date and clearly sign your name on the form received before submission to association office or committee chairman.
 - > The applicant shall submit originals or copies of each recap sheet containing highlighted eligible scores from designated leagues on application.
 - > It is requested that scores be turned in on a monthly basis. "No faxed documents will be accepted".
- 2. League Secretary.com or Bowling Center computer print-outs may also be submitted monthly by bowler.
 - ➤ Recap of scores may be given to any Committee/Board member, or emailed as an attachment to sdusbcallstars@yahoo.com or usbclynn@cox.net
 - ➤ It is the Bowlers responsibility to verify all scores for consideration have been received by SDUSBC association office or committee chairman, checked for accuracy, and completeness of said submissions by end of day May 31, 2015.
 - Only honor scores will be eligible for All-Star points from non-designated SDUSBC Certified Winter, Certified Summer leagues & Certified Tournaments. It is the bowler's responsibility to verify submittal of this information via original/copy of recap sheet, copy of League Secretary print-out or copy of bowling center computer print-out to the association office by end of day May 31, 2015.

D) Criteria for accumulating All-Star points:

- 1. League average of designated league on application as of May 31, 2015.
 - > 1 point per pin.
- 2. Only first three (3) games for series shall count regardless of the total number of games bowled in league or certified tournament.
 - Honor scores for the additional games will be recognized.
- 3. Scores from singles leagues do not qualify.
- 4. Sport League Averages will NOT be rerated for All Star Points.
- 5. Any 298-299-300 game bowled by a Youth Male or Female, or 700 series for male, or 600 for female, shall be considered honor scores.
