Guys and Gals Singles Tournament Rules

- 1. **ELIGIBILITY:** Current members of the San Diego USBC Bowling Association are eligible to participate in this Tournament. Membership card must be shown. Multi-Members must have purchased a Multi-Member Card (USBC Rule 101) and be currently bowling in a league in the San Diego Assoc. with 21 games or more as of Feb 15, 2015. (No Cards will be sold on site.)
- A. ENTERING AVERAGE RULES:
- 1. Entering average shall be the highest 2013-2014 San Diego Book average of 21 or more games winter or summer whichever is highest. If no book
- 2. Highest current average of 21 or more games as of Feb. 15, 2015. (With verification)
- 3. If none of the above the entering average will be 179 men 169 women.
- 4. If your February 15th average of 21 games or more is 10 pins or more higher than your highest SD 2013/2014 book average, summer or winter, you must use your highest average. League sheet must accompany entry.
- 5. USBC Rule 319a 2-3 will apply. 319d is waived for this tournament.
- B. Average Re-Rate and Adjustment: If you bowl in a standard (not a Sport or Sport Condition) league and have 21 games or more you will use your standard average. If you **ONLY** have a sport or sport condition average of 21 games or more you will use the sport average. The sport or sport condition average will be subject to re-rate according to the USBC Rule Book. If the bowler does not accept the re-rated average, the entry fee will be refunded.
- C. Failure to use correct average will disqualify scores.

GENERAL INFORMATION & RULES

- 1. This is a three (3) game singles event, handicap basis will be 90% of 200.
- 2. All prize monies will be returned 100%. Pay-off will be one (1) out of every six (6) entries.
- 3. A bowler arriving late may bowl, but their score will begin in the frame currently being bowled.
- 4. In the event a bowler cannot finish their series, zero will be given for the remaining frames.
- 5. USBC Rules will govern this tournament. The decision of the tournament committee shall be final unless an appeal is made in accordance with USBC Rule 329.

Dress Code

Entrants are expected to wear appropriate attire.

Examples of prohibited attire include but not limited to: Hats, tank tops. Halter tops, bare midriffs, spaghetti strap tops, workout attire, short-shorts, short skirts, bib overalls, jeans that are not in good condition, etc.

Bowlers will be required to change if attire is deemed inappropriate by tournament management. Tournament management's decision will be final.
