

SAN DIEGO USBC BOWLING ASSOCIATION

Youth Male and Female 2012 - 2013 All Star Team Requirements

A) Eligibility Requirements:

- 1. Be a member in good standing of the San Diego USBC.
- 2. Purchase your original membership card through the San Diego USBC.
- 3. Only events certified, sponsored or conducted by the San Diego USBC will be eligible for points.
- 4. Selections will be made on the basis of overall performance, sportsmanship and character.
 - A. Any bowler who exhibits poor sportsmanship during any San Diego USBC bowling event and is reported to the San Diego USBC association, is subject to disqualification.
 - B. Any bowler (or parent/guardian) who submits a <u>bad check</u> through San Diego USBC shall be subject to disqualification.
- 5. Must file an All-Star application with the association office or postmarked no later than November 15, 2012 to be eligible for the current season.
 - A. League name and bowling center must be designated clearly in the application.
 - B. The bowler is responsible to verify All-Star application is on file at association office.
 - C. May also be given to a San Diego USBC Board Member.
 - D. It is the **bowler's responsibility** to check for omissions/accuracy on printouts or recaps.
- 6. Must select sanctioned league under San Diego USBC jurisdiction in the current bowling year starting September, 2012 through May, 2013.
- 7. Must have a minimum average of; Male: 175, and Female: 155, from the current book.
- 8. Must have bowled 60 or more games in league designated on the application.

B) Method of turning in scores:

1. The All-Star committee/Board members will accept all applicants' scores for bowling year September, 2012 thru May, 2013. Accepting Committee/Board member is expected to write the date clearly on the form when received before submitting to association office or committee chairman.

The Committee/Board members will accept the following:

- A. The applicant shall submit originals or copies of each recap sheet containing highlighted eligible scores from the designated league on application. It is requested that scores be turned in on a monthly basis. No faxed documents will be accepted.
- B. League Secretary.com or Bowling Center print-outs may also be submitted monthly by bowler. Scores may be given to any Committee/Board member. Eligible scores need to be highlighted. It is the Bowlers responsibility to turn in all scores for consideration, and for accuracy of said submissions
- 2. Only honor scores will be eligible for All-Star points from non-designated San Diego USBC <u>certified</u> winter, summer leagues and tournaments. It is the bowler's responsibility to submit this *information via original/copy of recap sheet to the association office by end of May, 2013.*
 - A. Any 298-299-300 game bowled by a youth male or female, or 700 series for male, or 600 for female shall be considered honor scores. Point structure for Summer and Non-designated League(s) as printed in this section. (See point structure)
 - B. Points will also be awarded for 11 strikes in a row in any one game.

C) Criteria for accumulating All-Star points:

- 1. League average of designated league on application.
- 3. Only first three (3) game series shall count regardless of the total number of games bowled in a league or certified tournament.
 - A. Honor scores for additional games will be recognized.
- 4. Scores from singles league do not qualify. (Sport League averages will NOT be rerated for All Star Points)
- 5. Grade Point Average will be compiled from first (1st) semester report card. Original/copy will be accepted and must be turned in by end of **May**, **2013**.

D) Method of accumulating points:

1. League Average - 1 point per pin
