## SAN DIEGO SENIOR MENS MASTERS TOURNAMENT GENERAL PLAYING RULES

1. Open to all senior men (55 and over) as of the tournament date with a valid SAN DIEGO or NORTH COUNTY USBC Association sanction card.
2. Entry fee - \$70.00.
3. Check in time will be ONE HALF (1/2) HOUR prior to scheduled time of bowling.
4. BOWLERS WILL DRAW FOR STARTING LANE.
5. Qualifying rounds will consist of six ( 6 ) games bowled across twelve (12) lanes moving one pair of lanes to your right after each game.
6. Tardy bowlers will receive a zero for any frames missed during the qualifying rounds.
7. THERE WILL BE NO CARRY OVER OF PINS FROM THE QUALIFYING ROUNDS.
8. The 8 bowlers to qualify for finals is based on total pins for 6 games.
9. The top non-qualifier from the qualifying round will cash as $1^{\text {st }}$ alternate.
10. FINALS will be based on a match play system. Top qualifier will draw first for starting lane. Each qualifier shall bowl against every other finalist with a one game match on an 8 team schedule, with a position match at the end. Bowlers will be awarded 30 bonus pins for every match they win. In the event of a tie game during the finals, both bowlers will receive 15 bonus pins.
11. At the completion of the final competition, the bowler with the highest total pin fall, plus bonus pins will be the " 2006 SENIOR MENS MASTERS CHAMPION ".
12. The requirement of USBC rule 319d will be waived.
13. If a bowler who qualified for the finals is unable to bowl, the first alternate shall take his place in the schedule. If the first alternate is unavailable, then the next highest qualifier shall take his place. Any prize monies earned will be divided equally between the bowler and his replacement.
14. Tournament Committee shall decide any and all disputes. Their decision is final unless an appeal is made in accordance with USBC Rule 329.
