RULES

- 1. All bowlers must have a USBC Card.
- 2. One member must be entered and bowl in the 37th Annual Seniors Championships.
 - Their partner will have no age limit and will use their highest sanctioned league average (based on a minimum of 21 games) for the 2005-06 season. 2005-06 is meant to be the Book average published on or about April 15, 2006. If your Association does not publish a book at this time, furnish your book average as published near this date. Handicap will be 90% of 220. This Tournament does not use summer averages.
 - b. If you do not have the above, a bowler can use their last book average from a previous year. (Not to exceed three years)
 - c. If he/she has neither of the above two, he/she can apply to the Tournament Committee for an average or bowl scratch (220),
- 3. Averages must and will be verified.
- 4. Bowl as often as you wish but you must change partners. Entries close when squad is full.
- 5. Prize fund pays 100% one place for at least eight (8) entries.
- 6. Advance Entries must be paid in full by October 1st.
- 7. Have fun and Bowl.
- 8. No refunds on advance entries after October 5, 2006

TOURNAMENT RULES

- 1. This is a Team, Doubles, Singles and All-Events tournament open to all USBC California Bowlers 55 years old and over.
 - a. Bowlers MUST have reached their 55th birthday on or before the opening day of the Tournament.
 - b. This Tournament will have only one division or class for the Team Event.
 - c. The Doubles will have four divisions or classes, Combined ages:

A - 140 years and over

C - 120- 129 years

B - 130-139 years

D - 110- 119 years

Doubles partners do not have to be in the same age bracket.

d. The Singles and All-Events will have the following four divisions or classes:

A - 70 years and over

C - 60 to 64 years

B - 65 to 69 years

D - 55 to 59 years

- e. Bowlers are eligible to compete only once in each event. You may bowl doubles and singles without bowling the team event. To bowl doubles or singles you must enter both.
- f. BOWLERS MUST PRESENT THEIR USBC MEMBERSHIP CARD. Non-league bowlers can purchase an affiliate membership card from the Tournament Secretary.
- g. You may be requested to verify your age by showing a drivers license.
- 2. Bowlers will use their Highest sanctioned league average (based on a minimum of 21 games for the 2005-2006 season. The 2005-06 is meant to be the Book average as published on or about April 15, 2006. If your Association does not publish a book at this time, furnish your book as published near this date. Handicap will be 90% of 220. This tournament does not use summer averages.
 - a. If you do not have the above, a bowler can use their last book average from a previous year. (Not to exceed three years.)
 - b. If they have neither of the above two, a bowler with previous bowling experience can apply to the Tournament Committee for an average or bowl scratch (220).
 - c. All bowlers are responsible for personal knowledge of the re-rating requirements of USBC Rule #319e and any bowler failing to submit for re-rating when required according to this rule shall forfeit all entry fees and prize winnings and be liable for suspension from membership in the USBC.. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to re-rate a bowler prior to his participation in the Tournament.
 - d. Any bowler who has qualified for a prize of \$600.00 or more in any event of a tournament during the 12 months period prior to entry MUST report this for possible re-rate of average. Attach note with details. Failure to report will disqualify bowler. Rule 319a-2 and 319a-3 will be enforced.
- 3. All prize fees collected in an event or division of an event will be returned 100% to the participants in that event or division of that event.
 - a. Prizes will be awarded on a handicapped basis with at least one prize for each 8 entries.
- 4. On Doubles and Singles Singles will be bowled first on one pair of lanes then move to another pair for Doubles. (Six bowlers per pair). If a squad is small enough, we will schedule four bowlers per pair. NO REFUNDS AFTER OCTOBER 5th.
 - 5. Check in time, 45 minutes prior to squad time.
 - 6. All USBC Rules will govern.
